# The Lycan Coalition Endorsement Standards

(Internal Rubric – Transparent & Defensible)

---

## **A Candidate May Be Endorsed If They:**

- ✓ Support environmental protection grounded in reality
  - ✓ Affirm pluralism and human dignity
  - ✓ Support mental health education and access to resources
  - ✓ Demonstrate respect for democratic institutions
  - ✓ Take a realist, restrained approach to security and safety
- 

## **A Candidate May Be Recommended If They:**

- ✓ Align strongly on several core commitments
  - ⚠ Differ on others without hostility or dehumanization
  - ✓ Demonstrate good-faith governance
- 

## **A Candidate May Be Not Endorsed If They:**

- ✗ Reject pluralism or human dignity
  - ✗ Dismiss mental health needs or stigmatize care
  - ✗ Engage in coercive or dehumanizing politics
  - ✗ Promote institutional sabotage or reckless extremism
- 

### **Important Clarification**

Non-endorsement is not condemnation.

It simply means the Coalition does not actively endorse or recommend the candidate.

The Lycan Coalition does not nominate candidates, does not conduct primaries, and does not function as a political party.
